

ASTAR Air Cargo Requests Chief Administrative Law Judge Recuse Himself from Regulatory Proceeding

Lawyers representing ASTAR Air Cargo, Inc. late yesterday filed papers with Chief Administrative Law Judge Ronnie A. Yoder requesting that he remove himself from any further participation in the Department of Transportation case, which is considering allegations by ASTAR's competitors, Federal Express and UPS, that ASTAR is not a citizen of the United States.

The papers assert that the Chief Judge has prejudged the issues, is biased against ASTAR and is not capable of making an impartial decision.
